- 3. Use 12 point font (Times New Roman suggested)
- 4. Use one inch margins on sides, top and bottom
- 5. Double space all text lines
- 6. Use an academically accepted style for referencing sources, including maps and tables
- 7. Attach a cover page with the following information as indicated below:
