Submission deadline: Friday, September 16, 2022

Student extended abstracts must use the following format:

1. 1,200 words maximum of text. Cover page, literature cited page, figures, and tables do not count as text.
2. It is suggested that the extended abstract discuss, to the extent applicable, the following topics: introduction, background, methodology, results, conclusions
3. Use 12 point font (Times New Roman suggested)
4. Use one inch margins on sides, top and bottom
5. Double space all text lines
6. Use an academically accepted style for referencing sources, including maps and tables
7. Attach a cover page with the following information as indicated below:

Please note: **extended abstracts** are required for **poster** entries as well as paper presentation entries.
