Association of Pacific Coast Geographers (APCG)

Creative Educator Research Award

Purpose and Amount: This award recognizes educators who are APCG members and presenting at the APCG conference (paper or poster) and who do not hold tenured or tenure-track positions at a four-year college or university. Awardees may not be enrolled as students themselves. One award in the amount of \$500 will be given each year, and the selection committee judges will evaluate both the abstract and presentation. (The judges' decision is final and judges reserve the right to make no award in a given year.) **Application deadline is September 30.**

Eligibility: Awardees must be APCG members and must present at the APCG conference (paper or poster). Awardees must fit at least one of the following categories:

- 1) teaching at a community college,
- 2) teaching at a K-12 school,
- 3) adjunct instructor at a college or university,
- 4) holding a non-tenure-track position at a college or university,
- 5) engaged in education or teaching outside the traditional academic environment (for example, engaged in community education).

Application Process: To enter the award competition, please register for the APCG conference and submit the regular short abstract through the conference registration. Please also email your intent to participate to the Creative Educator Research Award contact person listed on the <u>APCG Awards, Grants, & Scholarships webpage</u> **by the end of the day on September 30** for full consideration.
