Submission deadline: Thursday, September 22, 2022

The APCG offers travel grants to attend the APCG Annual Meeting in Bellingham, WA, 6-8 October; the grant is \$200 for current Geography students who attend the meeting and \$300 for current Geography students who present papers or posters.

Undergraduate and graduate students of African Descent are welcome to apply for this scholarship. The application deadline is Thursday, 22 September 2022.

Application requires two steps:

1. A statement about the student's interests in geography, commitment to attend the Bellingham meeting, and, if presenting a paper or poster, the topic, and the student's ethnic background, and
2. A supporting letter of reference from a faculty member.
