Extended Abstract Format (For Doctoral Students Only)

Submission deadline: September 30.

Doctoral Students must use the following extended abstract format:

- 1) 1,200 words maximum of text. Cover page, literature cited page, figures, and tables do not count as text.
- 2) It is suggested that the extended abstract discuss, to the extent applicable, the following topics: introduction, background, methodology, results, conclusions.
- 3) Use 12-point font (Times New Roman suggested)
- 4) Use one-inch margins on sides, top and bottom.
- 5) Double space all text lines
- 6) Use an academically accepted style for referencing sources, including maps and tables.
- 7) Attach a cover page with the following information as indicated below:
 - a. Title of Paper
 - b. Author(s) Name(s)
 - c. Paper or Poster Competition

Please note: extended abstracts are required for poster entries as well as paper presentation entries.

SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS: Email (as MS Word attachments) your Extended Abstract (and any questions) to the Student Paper & Poster Competition's contact person listed on the <u>APCG Awards, Grants, & Scholarships webpage</u>. In the email subject line indicate: "APCG Student Paper/Poster Competition."

<u>Remember</u> that you must also submit a regular short abstract to the conference organizer, as part of the normal registration process.

Extended abstracts must be received NO LATER than September 30.
