Extended Abstract Format

All student extended abstracts must use the following format:

- 1. 1,250 words maximum of text. Cover page, literature cited page, figures, and tables do not count as text.
- 2. It is suggested that the extended abstract discuss, to the extent applicable, the following topics: introduction, background, methodology, results, conclusions
- 3. Use 12 point font (Times New Roman suggested)
- 4. Use one inch margins on sides, top and bottom
- 5. Double space all text lines
- 6. Use an academically accepted style for referencing sources, including maps and tables
- 7. Attach a cover page with the following information as indicated below:
